the Tribunal's quest for justice

00:00 How can the tribunal do justice? In my view it's very simple. We have to admit first that a tribunal cannot reach the exact truth – what happened exactly in all the cases. But the tribunal has an obligation to manage to be as close as that, as possible to that reality.

00:26 If everyone at the tribunal is doing his work professionally, ethically, I'm sure we will reach result which has not been biased by anyone, and that result in itself is already a kind of justice. And it's already good for our society.

00:46 It's only if we work in a way that we achieve other interest than that justice that we will be running far from justice and therefore from reconciliation.
